Terms of Agreement

APPLICATION PROCEDURE AND SELECTION: CYP is open to boys and girls who are 11 through 17 years of age who demonstrate a desire to participate in a positive and constructive outdoor, active, group camping experience. Applications are processed in the order in which they are received. When we have received your Application, signed Terms of Agreement and 20% deposit, we will contact you via email or phone confirming receipt. You will then be mailed a Registration Packet containing information and forms. These forms contain important information associated with the camp experience, the risks associated with the activities, and your responsibilities. Please read and complete these forms carefully. All forms must be completed and signed by the camper and parent/guardian. Final acceptance to a CYP program is contingent upon our communications with participant, parent/guardian, and others (e.g. physician, emergency contacts), our receipt and review of all Registration Forms, and the completion of all the registration requirements listed, provided that spaces and scholarships are still available.

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicant is 11-17 years old and demonstrates a desire to participate in all camp activities.
2. Completion & return of the **Application Form**.
3. Completion & return of all **Registration Forms**, which will be mailed upon receipt of your Application Form. The Registration Forms are to be completed by the camper and parent/guardian, and may require a doctor's signature. *ALL FORMS MUST BE COMPLETE!*
4. Payment of tuition.
5. **IF YOU ARE NEW TO CYP MOUNTAIN SUMMER CAMP.** completion of a scheduled Visitation Day and Camper Interview, both designed to better acquaint the camper and her/his parent/guardian with CYP staff, programs, and the camp property so that we can best serve the camper's individual needs. For out-of-state campers, we will conduct the interview over phone.

NON-DISCRIMINATION: CYP does not unfairly discriminate in its respective employment or admissions policies on the basis of race, color, gender, religion, sexual orientation, gender variance, national or ethnic origin, age or disability.

TUITION & SCHOLARSHIPS for Mountain Summer Camp: Full tuition for CYP Mountain Summer Camp is \$1,250 per camper. However, in an effort to make camp affordable for children from all economic backgrounds, CYP provides numerous scholarships that reduce the cost of tuition significantly. The different scholarship rates are based on income levels from the 2009 Area Median Income (AMI) for Boulder County, Colorado. In order to apply for grants to fund this scholarship program, CYP must be able to prove that it services low-income children. If you are requesting a reduced tuition for your camper, you must provide a copy of documentation that shows you qualify for assistance from Social Services, i.e. food stamps, housing subsidies, childcare assistance or AFDC. If you qualify for a scholarship as lower-income but do not receive assistance, please provide a copy of last year's tax return. *You must provide proof of a qualifying income to be eligible for any of the scholarship rates.* If after assessing your yearly income, you find that camp tuition is still not affordable for your family, please contact the Colorado Youth Program directly regarding a possible payment plan. CYP strives to have no child turned away because of financial matters, *but there are a limited number of spaces and scholarships available.* They will be filled first come, first served—we are expecting camp to fill quickly this year!

PAYMENT & REFUND POLICY: Full payment is due May 28, 2010 unless a payment plan has been approved by CYP. The 20% deposit mailed with this application directly applies toward camp tuition and will be fully refunded if the applicant is not accepted. Otherwise, all tuition refunds or extra charges will be made as follows:

- *Change sessions – there will be a \$25 charge.*
- *Cancel up to April 1 – there will be a \$50 charge.*
- *Cancel after April 1 yet before May 28 – you will be charged 50% of tuition.*
- *Cancel for any reason after May 28 – you will be charged the full tuition!*

The camper and his/her legal guardian acknowledge that if camper is dismissed or departs early from a program, *for any reason*, no refunds can be granted. Camper and guardian are responsible for all costs of early departure whether for medical reasons, dismissal, personal emergencies or otherwise.

PARTICIPANT BEHAVIOR: Both the Parent and his/her participating son/daughter understand that for the health and welfare of all members of a CYP session, participants are expected to behave appropriately throughout their stay on the program. CYP reserves the right to dismiss any participant from the program that staff believe, in their discretion, presents a safety concern or medical risk, is disruptive, or otherwise conducts him/herself in a manner detrimental to the program. Use of illegal drugs, tobacco products or alcohol, engaging in sexual harassment or bullying, or disregarding instructions are examples of conduct that CYP considers detrimental to the program, and that can lead to early dismissal.

FOR ALL CAMPERS AND PARENT/GUARDIANS: I have accurately completed the Application and have read, understand and agree to the Terms of Agreement outlined here. I agree to review all program materials sent and to complete all required registration forms. The parent gives his/her child permission to participate in all CYP program activities, at or away from camp property. All aspects of participant or parent relationship with CYP will be governed by Colorado law. A parent or legal guardian must sign below.
